

ORDINANCE NO. 946

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 111, SECTION 111.21 OF THE GOTHENBURG CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; ACQUISITION AND POSSESSION; RESTRICTIONS; ADDING EXEMPTION FOR PURCHASES FROM RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER OR EQUIVALENT, IF IMPORTED AMOUNT IS UNDER 108 LITERS; TO HARMONIZE WITH STATE LAW; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Section 111.21 of Title XI, Chapter 111 of Gothenburg's Code of Ordinances is revised to read as follows regarding alcoholic beverages:

ACQUISITION AND POSSESSION; RESTRICTIONS.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to purchase, receive, acquire, accept, or possess any alcoholic liquor acquired from any other person other than one duly licensed to handle alcoholic liquor under this chapter and the Nebraska Liquor Control Act unless within specific exemptions or exceptions provided in this chapter or the Act.

B. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, it shall be unlawful for any person to transport, import, bring, ship, or cause to be transported, imported, brought, or

shipped into this state for the personal use of the possessor, his or her family, or guests a quantity of alcoholic liquor in excess of nine liters in anyone calendar month.

(2) Division (B)(1) of this section does not apply to a person importing alcoholic liquor from a holder of a retail direct sales shipping license or its equivalent, which alcoholic liquor is for personal use or for use by such person's family or guests, if the total amount imported by such person in any one calendar year does not exceed 108 liters.

Section 2. Any other ordinance or code section passed and approved prior to passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
