

ORDINANCE NO. 982

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO alcoholic beverages; adding bottle club licensees to the requirement of frequent inspection; to harmonize with state law; to repeal conflicting ordinances and sections; and to provide an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The City of Gothenburg's Code of Ordinances is revised to read as follows regarding alcoholic beverages, bottle clubs, and inspections:

LICENSED PREMISES; INSPECTIONS.

The City Council shall cause frequent inspections to be made on the premises of all retail licensees and bottle club licensees. If it is found that any such licensee is violating any provision of this chapter, the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, or the rules and regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, or is failing to observe in good faith the purposes of this chapter or the Act, the license may be suspended, canceled, or revoked after the licensee is given an opportunity to be heard in his or her defense.

Section 2. Any other ordinance or code section passed and approved prior to passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is repealed,

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
