

## RESOLUTION 2021-26

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Article VII, Chapter 72, § 72.010 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code entirely prohibit, or fix a time limit for, the parking and stopping of vehicles on any street, streets, or district for a period of time longer than fixed in said Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gothenburg is the record owner of the following described real property (the "Real Property"):

Lot 7, Block 22, First Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County,  
Nebraska

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate to designate that parking on the Real Property shall be limited to 2-hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to mark as "2-hour Parking", in accordance with the Gothenburg Municipal Code, the Nebraska Revised Statutes and the Uniform Code Manual of Traffic Control Devices, the Real Property.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the markings and placement of appropriate signs.

Section 3. Any person parking a motor vehicle in the Real Property in violation of the "2-hour Parking" designation as set forth in this Resolution shall be deemed guilty of an offense, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than \$100 for each offense, pursuant to Section 72.999 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code.
