## **RESOLUTION 2022-4**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Title VII, Chapter 70, Section 70.06 of the Gothenburg Code of Ordinances, designate the locations of signs for the regulation of traffic, including Stop Signs at appropriate locations within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate for the safety of the public to place and remove Stop Signs at the intersections described in this resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to place a Stop Sign, in accordance with Title VII, Chapter 70, Section 70.06 of the Gothenburg Code of Ordinances, at the following locations in the city of Gothenburg, Nebraska, to wit:

- (a) at the intersection of 23rd Street and Avenue M and stopping West bound traffic on 23rd Street, prior to entrance onto Avenue M;
- (b) ) at the intersection of 23rd Street and Avenue L and stopping East bound traffic on 23rd Street, prior to entrance onto Avenue L;
- (c) at the intersection of Avenue L and 22nd Street stopping North and South bound traffic on Avenue L;

Section 2. The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to remove the Stop Sign, in accordance with Title VII, Chapter 70, Section 70.06 of the Gothenburg Code of Ordinances, at

at the intersection of Avenue L and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street stopping South bound traffic on Avenue L.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon placement of the appropriate signs.
