## **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

Greer discussed Resolution 2022-10 setting 2022-23 levy. Administrator Greer discussed the final budget amount of the property tax request - \$ 966,835. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 4 percent. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$0.328755 per \$100 of assessed value. The proposal to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$0.3737 per \$100 of assessed value. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of the City of will exceed last year's by Minus 9 % percent.
