

ORDINANCE 1021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE IX, CHAPTER 96, AMENDING SECTION 96.08 OF THE GOTHENBURG CODE OF ORDINANCES; AMENDING PROVISIONS FOR UNLICENSED OR INOPERABLE VEHICLE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

§ UNLICENSED OR INOPERABLE VEHICLE.

Section 1. Title IX, Chapter 96, Section 96.08 of the Gothenburg Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

(A) No person in charge or control of any property within the city, other than city property, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee, or otherwise, shall allow any partially dismantled, inoperable, wrecked, junked, or discarded vehicle to remain on that property longer than 30 days.

(B) No unlicensed vehicle shall be permitted to remain on any private or public property for any length of time, provided that this division shall not apply to the following:

(1) A vehicle bearing a valid In Transit sticker;

(2) A vehicle in an enclosed building;

(3) A vehicle on the premises of a business enterprise operated in a lawful place and manner when the vehicle is necessary to the lawful operation of the business; or

(4) A vehicle in an appropriate storage place or depository maintained in a lawful place and manner by the city.

(C) Any vehicle allowed to remain on property in violation of this section shall constitute a nuisance and shall be abated, and any person violating this section shall be guilty of an offense.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Exhibit A

**§ 96.08 UNLICENSED OR INOPERABLE VEHICLE.**

(A) No person in charge or control of any property within the city, other than city property, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee, or otherwise, shall allow any partially dismantled, inoperable, wrecked, junked, or discarded vehicle to remain on that property longer than 30 days.

(B) No unlicensed vehicle shall be permitted to remain on any private or public property for any length of time, provided that this division shall not apply to the following:
