RESOLUTION 2024-17

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, may, by Resolution, pursuant to Title VII §72.002 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code provide for one-way travel in any street or alley located in the city and shall provide for appropriate signs and marking when the same have been so designated;

WHEREAS, the owner of the property located at 814 Lake Avenue desires to establish a drive-through window option along the north side of said property; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it appropriate to designate as one-way travel to the west the 20-foot alley along the south side of Lots 1-5 and the north side of Lots 8-12, all in Block 9, First Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska (hereinafter referred to as the "Alley").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Travel along the Alley shall consist of one-way travel to the west from Lake Avenue.

Section 2. City Administration is hereby directed to post signage, along the Alley and surrounding right-of-way, identifying "One-Way Only," "Do Not Block the Sidewalk," "Do Not Enter" and "Exit Only," along with any additional signage as may reasonably be appropriate and consistent with standards of uniform traffic control.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately and all drivers will be required to obey the terms of this Resolution upon the markings and placement of appropriate signage.

Section 4. Any person operating a motor vehicle in the Alley in violation of this Resolution, shall be guilty of an offense and shall be punished in accordance with the terms of § 10.99 of the Gothenburg Municipal Code.
